PMGSY IN NAXAL AFFECTED REGIONS

864. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY KOTHA:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to use funds from Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) to improve road connectivity in naxal affected and backward regions of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, Statewise;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the quantum of funds allocated and utilized under PMGSY during the last three years and the current year, State-wise including Telangana?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

(a)to (c): Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) is a one-time special intervention to provide rural connectivity, by way of a single all-weather road, to the eligible unconnected habitations in the core network with a population of 500 persons and above (Census 2001) in plain areas. In respect of North Eastern States (i.e. Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura) and Hill States (i.e. Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir and Uttarakhand), the Desert Areas (as identified in the Desert Development Programme), the Tribal (Schedule V) areas and Selected Tribal and Backward Districts (as identified by the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) and the erstwhile Planning Commission), the objective is to connect eligible unconnected habitations with a population of 250 persons and above (Census 2001). In the critical 267 Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected blocks (as identified by MHA), additional relaxation has been given to connect habitations with population 100 persons and above (2001 census).

Under PMGSY, 6430 habitations with 100+ population in LWE areas have been sanctioned all-weather road connectivity. Till 06.02.2019, 2,461 habitations have been provided connectivity as per following details:-

Further, the Government launched "Road Connectivity project in LWE Affected Areas (RCPLWEA)" as a separate vertical under PMGSY to provide an all-weather road connectivity with necessary culverts and cross-drainage structures in 44 districts (35 are worst LWE affected districts and 09 are adjoining districts), which are critical from security and communication point of view. The current status of implementation of RCPWEA is given at Annexure-I.

(d): The Quantum of funds allocated/released and utilized under PMGSY during the last three years and the current year till 4th February, 2019, State –wise including Telangana is given at **Annexure-II.**
