Will the **Minister of FINANCE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the Land Customs Stations sanctioned and commissioned in the North East region; and
- (b) the details of the total funds sanctioned, released and utilised till date for developing the Land Customs Station at Dawki in Meghalaya?

ANSWER

(a) There are total 39 Land Customs Station in the North East region. Of these, 32 Land Customs Stations are on India- Bangladesh Border in the North-East region, 3 Land Customs Stations are on India-Myanmar Border and 4 Land Customs Stations are on India-Bhutan Border. The list is annexed.

(b) The Land Customs Station at Dawki, Meghalaya was established in 1948. The LCS premises building was constructed in 1998. The amount sanctioned and utilised for the establishment and construction of LCS was Rs.30.84 lakh.

Integrated Check Post is being constructed by Land Port Authority of India (LPAI) under Ministry of Home Affairs, at Dawki and the LCS at Dawki will be shifted to the ICP on completion of the same. The position of funds as on 31st January, 2019, for the ICP Dawki, Meghalaya as ascertained from LPAI is as follows:
