#### **ELECTRIFICATION OF RAILWAY LINES**

## \*177. SHRI UPENDRA SINGH RAWAT: SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is planning to take up electrification of railway lines in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;

(c) the details of the electrification of railway lines being taken up passing through Kurnool district of Andhra Pradesh along with the quantum of funds estimated to be spent thereon;

(d) the details of steps being taken by the Government to achieve/ensure the expeditious completion of electrification in Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu, particularly Chennai-Kanyakumari railway line; and

(e) the quantum of funds estimated to be spent on the electrification of all railway lines in the country, State/UT-wise?

(a) Yes, Sir. Ministry of Railways has planned to electrify balance Broad Gauge (BG) routes of Indian Railways, keeping in view the advantages of electrification and to achieve seamless operation on electric traction over entire Broad Gauge network.

(b) & (e) State-wise balance BG rail routes as on 01.04.2019, planned for electrification with estimated expenditure are given below:-

(c) Details of un-electrified railway lines passing through Kurnool District, being taken up for electrification are as under:-

(i) Gadwal-Kurnool City-Dhone railway line: It is part of Manmad-Mudkhed-Dhone electrification project, sanctioned at a cost of ₹ 664.50 crore.

(ii) Nandyal-Sanjamala-Yerraguntla railway line: Electrification of this section has been sanctioned at a cost of ₹111.48 crore.

(d) In the State of Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu, the electrification works are in progress for 2,446 and 1,552 BG Route Kilometers respectively.

To expedite electrification of railway lines in the country, including States of Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu, steps taken include award of Engineering Procurement and Construction (EPC) contracts, better project monitoring mechanism, delegation of more power to field units for award of contracts/sanction of estimates and close monitoring at highest level.

Chennai - Kanniyakumari rail route (via Villupuram & Tiruchchirappalli) has already been electrified.
