STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 211 RAISED BY SHRI K. NAVASKANI, HON'BLE MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT TO BE ANSWERED ON 8<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2019 REGARDING KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS.

- (a) Kendriya Vidyalaya, Mandapam in Ramanathapuram District is functioning from its permanent building since 1996. KV, Rameswaram in Ramanathapuram District is functioning from temporary building provided free of cost by the State Government.
- (b) Yes, Sir. It is proposed to construct new building for the KV at Rameswaram.
- (c) & (d) Construction of permanent buildings for KVs is a continuous process, which depends upon identification of suitable land, completion of land transfer formalities, submission of drawings/estimates by construction agency, availability of funds and requisite approvals etc.
