**(a) to (c): Development and promotion of tourism is primarily the responsibility of the concerned State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. The Ministry of Tourism, however, under its Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and Assistance to Central Agencies scheme guidelines, provides central financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory (UT) Administrations/Central Agencies for development of tourism infrastructure in the country. The projects for development under the above schemes are identified in consultation with the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations/Central Agencies and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable detailed project reports, their adherence to relevant scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier.**
