(a) to (d): Survey for Kanhangad-Panathur-Kaniyuru new line (90.50 Km) was sanctioned in the financial year 2014-15. Field survey of the proposed new line has been completed. 50 Km of the project alignment falls in Kerala and balance 40.50 Km falls in Karnataka. In this regard, data collected by the field unit has been verified and yard diagrams of the proposed new line have been firmed up. Accordingly, survey report, estimate and plans of the proposed new line are under finalization. Further consideration of this proposal is possible after the survey report is received and results thereon are firmed up.
