- (a) whether the export of textiles and apparel has been falling every month for the last three years despite the Government's efforts to give the segment a boost, if so, the extent to which it has declined alongwith the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether data compiled by the Confederation of Indian Textile Industry (CITI) showed sharp decline in the export of textile and apparel since 2017 as compared to 2013-14,2014-15 and 2015-16, year-wise, if so, the response of the Union Government in this regard; and
- (c) whether the Government is aware that the industry needs immediate relief in the form of a minimum two per cent on the Merchandise Export from India Scheme on cotton yarn and a RoSL package for fabric and cotton yarn to retain competitiveness in the global market and if so, the steps taken by the Union Government in this regard?

- (a): As per DGCIS data, export of textile and apparel has been increasing by around 2% CAGR in last three years i.e. from 2016-17 to 2018-19.
- **(b):** As per the data of Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics, export of textile and apparel has increased by 2.3% year on year from US\$ 35.7 bn in 2017-18 to US\$ 36.6 bn in 2018-19. Export of textile and apparel year-wise in 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16 is as follows:

(c): The export of cotton yarn and fabric has been growing year on year in last three years i.e. 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19. Export of cotton yarn and fabric during last three years is as follows:
