Will the Minister of DEFENCE j{kk ea=h be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of military and sainik schools in the country as on date, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the sainik schools in different States have produced some of the best officers in the Indian Armed Forces and eminent personalities in almost all walks of life and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up more such sainik schools in the country and if so, the details thereof, State/UT and location-wise;
- (d) if not, whether the Government proposes to set up a Committee for this purpose;
- (e) whether the Government is satisfied with the performance/standard of education of the said sainik schools and if so, the details thereof;
- (f) if not, the remedial measures taken/being taken by the Government to maintain high standard of education in these schools; and
- (g) whether there is any proposal to increase the budget allocation to all the existing sainik schools through the Sainik School Society, Ministry of Defence and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (g): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (g) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION No.67 FOR ANSWER ON 26.06.2019 REGARDING MILITARY AND SAINIK SCHOOLS

- (a) There are 31 Sainik Schools and 05 Rashtriya Military Schools (details are at **Annexure-I).**
- (b) Yes, Sir. Sainik Schools have produced some of the best officers in the Indian Armed Forces and eminent personalities. The details of some of the eminent Alumni of Sainik Schools is at **Annexure-II**.
- (c) Yes, Sir. Government proposed to establish 05 Sainik Schools. A Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) has been signed with the State Government for 05 schools which is done after State Government provides the land free of cost and construction budget. The details are at **Annexure-III**.
- (d) No need for a Committee is felt.
- (e)& (f): Yes, Sir. The Government is satisfied with the performance /standard of education of Sainik Schools. Sainik Schools have proven their utility by providing a large number of cadets joining the National Defence Academy/Indian Naval Academy/Technical Entry Schemes etc. The year wise number and percentage of cadets sent to National Defence Academy from Sainik Schools for last three years is as follows:-

(g) The Central Government is providing financial assistance to all Sainik Schools for Infrastructure development, IT/Training Grant, Defence Scholarship, Central Assistance, additionality in pay & allowances/pension of Sainik School employees consequent to implementation of Pay Commission, NDA incentive etc. The details of financial assistance to Sainik Schools provided by Central Government in the last three year is as under:-

At present, there is no proposal to enhance the budget allocation to Sainik Schools.
