- (a) whether the protective railings and the street lamps installed on both sides of some of the expressways are being stolen thereby enhancing the risk for the commutors;
- (b) if so, the precaution the Government proposes to ensure that such theft does not recur and the road users are safe;
- (c) whether the Government would consider installing surveillance cameras to catch such culprits who cause hindrance to the development and progress of the States; and
- (d) if so, the time by which a final decision in this regard is likely to be taken?
