**PROTECTION FROM FLOODS**

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken or proposes to take any steps to protect Mallawan, Bilgram, Bharavan and Sandila areas of district Hardoi in Misrikh region of Uttar Pradesh from the flood arising out of the Ganga and Gomti rivers;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) Irrigation and Water Resources Department, Government of Uttar Pradesh has prepared a scheme named “Flood Protection from Harpalpur Sandi Bridge to Mehandighat Bridge by construction of marginal bund on left bank of river Ganga in Mallawan Tehsil, Bilgram District Hardoi, Uttar Pradesh”. The estimated cost of the scheme is Rs.280.382 crores and the length of the marginal bund is 36.5 kms. This scheme envisages protecting eight villages of Bilgram Tehsil from floods. As far as river Gomti is concerned, State Government of Uttar Pradesh has informed that at present there is no problem related to erosion of banks of river Gomti in the Bharavan Tehsil, Sandila area of District Hardoi of Uttar Pradesh.

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
