# UPGRADING DISTRICT HOSPITALS INTO MEDICAL COLLEGES

#### 1228. SHRI AJAY MISRA TENI:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is considering to convert 75 district hospitals into medical colleges with a view to ensure availability of doctors and para medical facilities in healthcare sector;

(b) if so, the details thereof, district and hospital-wise; and

(c) the funds likely to be spent by the Government in upgrading district hospitals as medical colleges?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) to (c): With a view to increase the availability of doctors in the country, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme for "Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals". The fund sharing ratio between the Central Government and States under the Scheme is 90:10 for NE/Special Category states and 60:40 for other States.

No proposal to set up 75 more medical colleges under this scheme has so far been approved.
