1273. SHRI BALAK NATH:

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up any naturopathy wellness centres in various parts of the country, especially in Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the time by which such centres are likely to be set up;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether specific guidelines have been set in this regard, if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether a new naturopathy policy is likely to be formulated in the near future and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a) to (d): Public Health is a State subject. Setting up of Naturopathy Wellness Centres comes under purview of State/UT Governments. However, Central Government is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) in the country including Rajasthan under which there is a provision for financial assistance to States/UTs for setting up of AYUSH Wellness Centres including Yoga & Naturopathy. However, no proposal received from the State of Rajasthan for this purpose under National AYUSH Mission.
- (e): There is no such proposal.
