1275. SHRI SRINIVAS KESINENI:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the aims and objectives of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY);
- (b) the AIIMS like hospitals established under PMSSY scheme, State/ UT-wise;
- (c) the number of AIIMS like hospitals proposed to be established under phase-II/III of PMSSY; and
- (d) the funds estimated, sanctioned, released and proposed to be released for AIIMS at Mangalagiri in Andhra Pradesh?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a): Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) aims at correcting the imbalances in the availability of affordable healthcare facilities in the different parts of the country in general, and augmenting facilities for quality medical education in the under-served States in particular. PMSSY, a Central Sector Scheme, has two components –
- (i) Setting up of AIIMS-like institutions; and
- (ii) Up-gradation of existing State Government Medical College/Institutions
- (b): Six (6) new AIIMS in Patna (Bihar), Raipur (Chhattisgarh), Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh), Bhubaneswar (Orissa), Jodhpur (Rajasthan) and Rishikesh (Uttaranchal) have been established under PMSSY and are functional.
- (c): An AIIMS in Rae Bareli has been approved to be established under Phase-II of PMSSY. However, no AIIMS was proposed to be established under Phase-III of PMSSY.
- (d): AIIMS Mangalagiri was approved in Phase-IV at a sanctioned cost of Rs. 1618 crore. Out of which, Rs. 385.54 crore have been released so far. Fund utilized till date is Rs. 367.7 crore.
