#### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO PREVENT CANCER AND TB

#### 1277. SHRI CHUNNI LAL SAHU:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of international financial assistance sought and received to prevent cases of Cancer and TB in the country during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (b) whether funds have been allocated to certain Non-Government Organisations (NGOs) for the said purpose; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof across the country during the said period, State/UT wise?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a): Financial assistance has been received from Global Fund for AIDS, TB & Malaria (GFATM) for Revised National Tuberculosis Control Programme (RNTCP), during each of the last three years and the current year as per details at **Annexure-I**.

The International financial assistance covers the following TB control activities:

- (i) Procurement of Second Line Drugs
- (ii) Strengthening of RNTCP Lab Network
- (iii) Strengthening of RNTCP Information Technology systems.
- (iv) Drug Resistant TB Patient Direct Benefit Transfer(DBT) incentive support
- (v) Active Case Finding
- (vi) Engagement with Private Sector

Regarding cancer, technical collaboration exists with international organizations.

(b) & (c): The details of funds allocated to Civil Society Organizations for the said purpose is at **Annexure-II.** 

The fund allocated for during the said period has been done at the National level and there is no specific State/UT wise allocation.
