AYURVEDA HEALTH CLINICS

1282. SHRI Y.S. AVINASH REDDY:

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is planning to set up Ayurveda Health Clinics across the country to boost the rural health;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the other facilities being provided in the Primary Health Centres?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a) to (c) Public Health is a State subject. Setting up of Ayurveda Health Clinics comes under purview of State/UT Governments. However, Central Government is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) across the country including rural area to boost the health services through the following activities:
- (i) Co-location of AYUSH facilities at Primary Health Centers (PHCs), Community Health Centers (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs).
- (ii) Up gradation of exclusive State Government AYUSH Hospitals and Dispensaries.
- (iii) Setting up of up to 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital.
- (iv) Supply of essential drugs to AYUSH Hospitals and Dispensaries.

Through these centres AYUSH healthcare services and medicines including Ayurveda are being provided to the public.
