- (a) whether Delhi University has any proposal to introduce entrance test for all college admissions;
- (b) if so, the details and the reasons therefor along with the graduate and post graduate courses for which Delhi University conducts computer-based entrance tests;
- (c) whether class XII marks will also be taken into account while deciding college admission;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the time by which the Delhi University plans to introduce entrance exam based admission for all its undergraduate courses?

(a) to (e): University of Delhi has informed that there is no proposal to introduce entrance test for all college admissions. The University has been conducting entrance test for the Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses for the past several years. However, the computer based entrance tests have been introduced since 2018. The University conducts entrance test for all PG courses and following Undergraduate courses:
