Girl Education

1483. SHRI JAGDAMBIKA PAL:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the proportion of total education budget being utilized for the education of girls in the country;
- (b) whether any financial assistance is given to girl students passing class VII for improving and promoting girl enrollment in secondary education;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the amount released and utilized under said scheme during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise; and
- (e) the other steps being taken by the Government in this regard?

(a): Gender Budget of Department of School Education and Literacy for the year 2018-19 is at Annexure-I.

(b) & (c): The Centrally Sponsored Scheme of “National Scheme of Incentive to Girls for Secondary Education (NSIGSE)” covers (i) all girls belonging to SC/ST communities who pass class VIII and (ii) all girls who pass VIII examination from Kasturba Gandhi BalikaVidyalayas (irrespective of whether they belong to SC/ ST) and enroll in class IX in Government, Government-aided and Local Body schools. The sanction of funds is made on the receipt of proposals/ list of eligible girls from respective States/UTs. According to the scheme, a sum of Rs.3000/- is deposited in the name of eligible unmarried girls as fixed deposit on enrolment in class IX, who are entitled to withdraw it along with interest thereon reaching on 18 years of age and passing class 10th class examination. In the year 2018-19, 548396 girls have been benefited under this scheme.

(d): Details of fund allocated sanctioned and the number of girls benefited during the year 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19 under NSIGSE is at Annexure-II.

(e): In order to ensure greater participation of girls in education, Samagra Shiksha an integrated scheme of school education has targeted interventions for girls which include Opening of schools in the neighbourhood, Provision of free text-books to Girls up to Class VIII, Uniforms to all girls up to Class VIII, Provision of gender segregated toilets in all schools, Teachers' sensitization programmes to promote girls' participation, Provision for Self-Defence training for the girls from classes VI to XII, Stipend to CWSN girls from class I to Class XII, Up-gradation of KGBVs for Girls from classes VI - VIII to classes VI – XII, Construction of residential quarters for teachers in remote/hilly areas/in areas with difficult terrain.

In addition, Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs) have been opened in Educationally Backward Blocks (EBBs) where the female rural literacy is below the national average. KGBVs are residential schools for girls belonging to disadvantaged groups such as SC, ST, OBC, Minority and Below Poverty Line (BPL) from Class VI to XII. Presently, total 5970 KGBVs have been sanctioned in the country out of which 4841 KGBVs are operational enrolling 5.60 lakh girls.
