DOUBLE SHIFTS IN KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA

1494. SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to start second shift in Mashrak Kendriya Vidyalaya of Saran to accommodate maximum children of the nearby localities:
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the said proposal is likely to be implemented and if not the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any initiative to construct own building of Maharajganj Kendriya Vidyalaya of Saran which is running on rent;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the school starts functioning from its own building; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

- (a) No such proposal is under consideration of the Government at present, including in Mashrak Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV) of Saran.
- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) to (e) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that the matter for transfer of land for construction of permanent building at KV Maharajganj of Saran has been taken up with State Government of Bihar, but, land has not been transferred in favour of KVS so far. Construction of permanent buildings for KVs is a continuous process, which depends upon identification of suitable land, completion of lease formalities in favour of KVS by the sponsoring authorities, submission of drawings / estimates by construction agency, availability of funds and requisite approvals etc. As such, no specific time frame can be given in this regard.
