RURAL WOMEN WORKFORCE

1554. DR. UMESH G. JADHAV:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the estimated number of rural women workforce employed in nonfarm sector, State-wise;
- (b)the measures taken by the Government towards the skill development of these workers in this sector;
- (c)whether there is a discrimination faced by the women in non-farm sector, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d)the measures taken by the Government to curb these discriminations?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

- (a): No such data is maintained by the Ministry of Labour and Employment.
- (b): The National Skill Development Mission (NSDM) was launched to provide a strong institutional framework to implement and scale up skill development efforts across the country and to impart training to workers including rural women employed in non-farm sector. The Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana is implemented by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship to provide for short term training to the youth through affiliated training partners/training centres, both in urban and rural areas.
- (c) & (d): No such complaints are received in Ministry of Labour and Employment.
