(a)to(e) The University of Delhi has informed that it has decided to construct a college on a piece of land measuring 83 Bighas and 19 Biswas (16.79 acres) at Village Roshanpura, Najafgarh. Further it has initiated the process to appoint CPWD as PMC to construct the college at the proposed land and according to the proposal, the duration of construction activity is approximately 4 years.
