Jan Aushadi Shops

1576. SHRI Y.S. AVINASH REDDY:

Will the Minister of **CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS**, be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Government has directed all the State Governments to ensure opening of Jan Aushadi Shops in the premises of every Hospital in the State with a view to provide affordable medicines to the people;
- (b) whether the Government has made any study on the implementation of the said order in each of the State and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the State Governments have given any feedback adhering to the directions of the Government;
- (d) whether some States are still lagging behind in opening of these Jan Aushadi Shops in the Hospital areas;
- (e) the action being taken by the Government against the States where these shops have not been opened till now; and
- (f) the steps being taken by the Government to ensure compliance of its orders by the State Governments?

<u>ANSWER</u>

MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI D. V. SADANANDA GOWDA)

- (a) The Government of India has requested the State Governments to provide space in government hospitals for opening of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs).
- (b) to (e) In pursuance to the request made by Government of India, various State Governments have responded and have provided space in government hospitals for PMBJKs. A state-wise list of PMBJKs functional in Government premises is enclosed as Annexure-I.
- (f) The Bureau of Pharma Public Sector Undertakings of India (BPPI), the implementing agency for this scheme is continuously pursuing the matter with all the State Governments.
