PM-KISAN CREDIT CARD SCHEME

1677. SHRIMATI POONAMBEN MAADAM:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has urged all the States and Union Territories (UTs) to expedite farmers' enrollment process to get the benefit under the PM-Kisan Credit Card Scheme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the implementation plan and the targets that have been set for the same;
- (c) whether States have been identified where KCC penetration was found lagging; and
- (d) if so, the details to expedite the process to achieve the targets?

ANSWER

(a): Yes Sir.

(b) to (d): As per the advisory issued by the Department for Kisan Credit Card (KCC) saturation drive, the implementation plan is as under :

- (i) Camps to be Organized Bank-wise / village-wise to collect Kisan Credit Card (KCC) application forms from eligible farmers
- (ii) The District Level Bankers Committee (DLBC) to decide the modalities of the camp and the date wise schedule
- (iii) District Collector and Lead District Manager (LDM) to play a key role in the campaign for all these activities carried out for KCC saturation
- (iv) In the camps, the State machinery to facilitate completion of application forms which includes documentation like identity proof , Residence proof, Land records and one photograph
- (v) Applications collected in the camps to be submitted to the Bank's branch and KCC to be issued within 2 weeks from the receipt of completed application.

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- (vi) Details of Aadhar Card Number of the applicants to be captured
- (vii) The progress will be monitored by State Level Bankers Committee (SLBC).

KCC enrollment is a continuous process and it is Government's intent to cover every eligible farmer with KCC. Union Government is closely working with States and progress is being monitored through Video Conference (VC) by Government of India, District level target monitoring by the States and visit of Central Teams to selected States especially where KCC penetration is less.
