Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken note of reports that Islamic State (IS) was targeting to attack tourist places in Kerala;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard;
- (c) whether the National Investigation Agency (NIA) or any other agency has busted an IS module in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) to (b): Intelligence inputs on terror threats are regularly shared with State Governments / Agencies concerned with advice to take appropriate measures and sensitize their field formations to prevent any untoward incident.
- (c) to (d): In connection with 3 IS related cases, NIA had conducted raids in Kerala (April, 2019) and in Tamil Nadu (June 2019) and arrested 4 persons.
