GROUND WATER RECHARGE WORK UNDER MGNREGS

1777. SHRI MANICKAM TAGORE B.:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of ground water recharge related works carried out under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme(MGNREGS) during the last three years and ongoing works during this current year in Tamil Nadu;
- (b) the total amount allotted and spent under various programmes mentioned above during the last three years;
- (c) the number of works started and works that remained incomplete with respect to the above works in Tamil Nadu along with the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the time by which the incomplete/ongoing works are likely to be completed?

(a) to (c): As per the Schedule-I of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 (MGNREGA), 'Public works relating to Natural Resource Management (NRM): (i) Water conservation and water harvesting structures to augment and improve ground water like underground dykes, earthen dams, stop dams, check dams with special focus on recharging ground water including drinking water sources are permissible activity'. Details of number and expenditure on Water Conservation and Water Harvesting works taken up and completed works under MGNREGA in Tamil Nadu during the last three years and the current financial year 2019-20 (as on 28.06.2019) are as under:
