- (e) whether the Government has created conducive atmosphere for investments to boost 'Make in India' drive; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken to boost 'Make in India' drive?

वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्री (श्री पीयूष गोयल) THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

- (a) to (d): Activities under the Make in India initiative are undertaken, through schemes/ programmes, by several Central Government Ministries/Departments and various State Governments from time to time. Details of such schemes/programmes and their impact is not centrally maintained.
- (e) & (f): Government has taken several initiatives to create a conducive atmosphere for investments and to boost Make in India which, interalia, includes liberalisation of Foreign Direct Investment regime, Ease of Doing Business, Startup India, Skill India and sectoral schemes/programmes to improve competitiveness in the country.
