- (a) whether the Railways have identified old and defunct Railway tracks in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Karnataka;
- (c) whether the Railways have decided to restore such defunct railway tracks; and
- (d) if so, the State-wise details thereof including the number of such tracks currently under restoration/to be restored?

(a) and (b): Yes, Sir. As per survey conducted in March, 2015, there is no identified old and defunct railway line in Karnataka. However, the old and defunct railway tracks identified in the country State-wise are as under:-

(c) and (d): Yes, Sir. Railway has identified to restore the defunct railway tracks (9 lines out of 21 indicated above) and the work of restoration has been taken up; details of such lines is as given below:-
