(a& b): Coal Exploration Survey is a continuous process. After completion of exploration survey in a block, coal resources assessed and reported in Geological Report. As per coal Inventory of India published by Geological Survey of India (GSI), coal resources added by all agencies during last 5 years are given below:

(c& d): Availability of coal in Churu and Bikaner area of Rajasthan is not yet confirmed and accordingly, presently, there is no proposal to carry out mining of coal in that area.
