- (a) the names of airports in Bihar where upgradation work is under way along with the target date fixed to complete the said work;

(a): The Airports Authority of India (AAI) has undertaken the upgradation work at Patna and Gaya Airports in Bihar with the Projected Date of Completion (PDC) in October, 2022 and March, 2020 respectively.

(b): AAI has earmarked a sum of Rs. 1216.90 Crore and Rs. 24.81 Crore for the development of Patna and Gaya airports respectively and so far an expenditure of Rs. 35.50 Crore and Rs. 5.09 Crore has been incurred on the two airports respectively.

(c): There is no such delay in the projects.
