URBAN PLANNING IN METROPOLITAN CITIES

No. 2043. SHRI PARVESH SAHIB SINGH:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has carried out any study/research/survey on the need of new techniques in urban planning in Metropolitan cities and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the urban planning for Delhi is done in coordination with the urban transport system and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the list of all international technical assistance and cooperation received in development of metropolitan areas in Delhi during the last five year?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a): Urban Planning is a State subject. However, for the guidance of the States / UTs, this Ministry has framed the Urban and Regional Development Plan Formulation and Implementation (URDPFI) Guidelines 2014. These guidelines *inter-alia* prescribe new techniques in urban planning using geographical information systems and remote sensing.

(b): Yes Sir, urban planning for Delhi is done in coordination with the urban transport system. In the base lining phase of Master Plan for Delhi (MPD) 2041, DDA is consulting all the stakeholders including those related to the urban transport system.
