(a) &(b): Yes Sir, Government has launched 'Star rating protocol for garbage free cities' under the Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) to motivate cities to achieve garbage free status.

(c) to(f): 'Star rating protocol for Garbage Free Cities (GFC)' is based on a SMART framework --Single metric, Measurable, Achievable, Rigorous verification mechanism and Targeted towards outcomes. Cleanliness indicators for GFC at both ward and city levelincludes door to door collection, segregation at source, public sweeping, provision of litter and/ or storage bins, processing of wet and dry waste, compliance of SWM Rules for bulk waste generators, penalties, spot fines & user charges, scientific landfill, cleanliness of drains & water bodies, screening of Nallahs, plastic waste management, managing construction & demolition resolution of citizen complaints, beautification with sustainability, etc.
