- (a) whether the Government builds roads under Central Road Fund (CRF) as per the recommendation of the States;
- (b) if so, the details of the roads constructed during the last three years in the country under CRF, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether any proposal under CRF from the State Government of West Bengal is pending and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government regarding speedy implementation and monitoring of funds under CRF?

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The state wise details of State Roads (non-Rural) constructed under CRF for all the States/Union Territories, during the last three years are annexed.
- (c) No proposal is pending under CRF for the state Government of West Bengal
- (d) The State Governments directly execute the works sanctioned under CRF. Ministry monitors the progress of the works based on Utilization Certificate (UC) and releases the funds based on UC.
