Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Panchayats assisted so far and the number of persons trained under the National Rural Drinking Water Quality Monitoring and Surveillance Programme during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise; and;
- (b) the funds provided during the said period, State/UT-wise?

- (a) The state wise details of number of persons trained under Water Quality Monitoring and Surveillance component of the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) during 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 (up to 26th June, 2019) as reported by the States into Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of the department is at **Annexure-I**.
- (b) States can utilize up to 5% of funds released to them under NRDWP for water quality monitoring and surveillance, which, inter alia, includes testing of drinking water sources at the Panchayat level by using simple field test kits, upgrading of existing water quality testing laboratories and setting up of new State/district/sub-district / mobile water quality testing laboratories wherever such facility is not available or needed

State/ UT wise funds released under the Water Quality Monitoring and Surveillance(WQMS)component for the year 2016-17 and total fund released under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) (up to 5 % of fund released can be utilised for WQMS) during the year 2017-18 and 2018-19is at **Annexure-II**. No release has been made during the current year 2019-20 so far.
