- (a) the number of National and State Highways in Jharkhand;
- (b) the details of State roads that have been declared as new NHs in the State of Jharkhand during the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government has provided funds for development of the above new NHs; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the amount of contracts for the said roads and the funds released and utilised thereon, project-wise?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs) in the country. At present, there are 30 (thirty) nos. of NHs in the State of Jharkhand. These are NH-18, 19, 20, 22, 33, 39, 43, 49, 114A, 118, 133, 133A, 133B, 139, 143, 143A, 143B, 143D, 143H, 143AG, 218, 220, 320, 320D, 320G, 333, 333A, 343, 419 & 522.
- (b) The details of State roads that have been declared as new NHs in the State of Jharkhand during the last three years is at Annexure.
- (c) & (d) Central Government takes up development and maintenance of these newly declared NHs after entrustment of these NHs to the respective implementing agencies, viz. State Government/NHAI.

1	NH-143B	Junction with NH-43 near Jaspurnagar (Chhattisgarh) connecting Govindpur, Dumri and terminating near Mahuadanr in Jharkhand
2	NH-143D	Junction with NH-143 near Jamtoli connecting Basia, Kamadara, Torpa and terminating at its junction with NH-20 near Khunti in Jharkhand
3	NH-143H	Junction with NH-143 near Joramin Jharkhand connecting Ambapani in Odisha
4	NH-143AG	Junction with NH-143A near Lohardaga connecting Bhandra, Bero, Karra, Khunti and terminating at its junction with NH-43 near Tamar
5	NH-218	Junction with NH-18 near Purulia in West Bengal connecting Chandankyari, Jhariya and terminating at its junction with NH-18 near Dhanbad in Jharkhand
6	NH-320D	Junction with NH-20 near Chakradharpur connecting Sonua, Goelkera, Manoharpur, Jaraikela in Jharkhand and terminating at its junction with NH-143 (Rourkela Bypass) in Odisha
7	NH-320G	Junction with NH-20 near Hat Gamaria connecting Jagannathpur, Baraiburu, Saddle, Manoharpur, Anandpur, Bano and terminating at its junction with NH-143 near Kolebira
