**INCREASING SEATS IN  
KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS**

**225. SHRI PARVESH SAHIB SINGH:**

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has increased seats of Kendriya Vidyalayas in the country including Delhi during the last five years and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the average student-teacher ratio in Kendriya Vidyalayas in Delhi as of June 2019;
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to improve infrastructure and technology in Kendriya Vidyalayas in the country including Delhi during said period?

- (a) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that the enrolment of students in Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in the country including Delhi is gradually increased during the last five years, as per the details given below : -

2014-15	11,76,682
2015-16	12,05,760
2016-17	12,27,951
2017-18	12,54,922
2018-19	12,75,795

- (b) The average student-teacher ratio in the KVs in Delhi, as of June 2019, is 34:1.
- (c) Budgetary support is provided every years as Grant-in-Aid – Creation of Capital Assets for meeting the requirement of KVS for development of infrastructure, computerization etc. The budgetary support provided to KVS during the last five years as capital grant is as under:-
