- (a) whether the Government has asked the Federation of Indian Export Organisations to submit a report on issues like shifting from subsidies to cheaper availability of loan in foreign currency etc.;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises would benefit out of it and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The Government of India conducts studies on issues such as export subsidies and export credit from time to time. Most of these studies indicate that the Indian Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises would benefit from both export subsidies and cheaper availability of loans in foreign currency.
