Students' Performance in Navodaya Vidyalaya

2325. SHRI MOHANBHAI KALYANJI KUNDARIYA:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has assessed the academic performance of students of the Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs) functioning in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof during the last three years and the current year, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to open JNVs in each district in the country particularly in the rural areas in order to improve the standard of education as well as provide technical education to the poor students;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken/being taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (e) the other steps taken by the Government to improve the education standard of JNVs?

ANSWER MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

- (a) and (b): The academic performance of students of the JNVs are assessed as per norms of Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) regularly. Details of academic performance during the last three years and the current year are annexed.
- (c) and (d): Navodaya Vidyalaya Scheme envisages opening of one JNV in each district of the country. Opening of new JNVs is a continuous process which depends on the willingness of the concerned State Government to make available requisite suitable land free of cost for construction of the permanent building and making available required temporary building, free of rent, to run the Vidyalaya till the permanent building is constructed. However, actual sanction and opening of new JNV depends on availability of funds and approval by the Competent Authority. One JNV each has been sanctioned in all the districts of the country (as on 31st May, 2014). The state of Tamil Nadu has not yet accepted the Navodaya Vidyalaya Scheme.
- (e): NVS is providing continuous training to JNV teachers to upgrade their skills. In addition the students are also supported with modules on experiential learning, practice papers, remedial teaching and videos of classes by expert teachers based on observations made during periodical inspections of Vidyalayas.
