(a) & (b) To protect, promote and preserve various forms of folk arts and culture throughout the country, the Government of India has already set up seven Zonal Cultural Centres (ZCCs) with headquarters at Patiala, Nagpur, Udaipur, Prayagraj, Kolkata, Dimapur and Thanjavur. These ZCCs organize various cultural activities and programmes in all the States/UTs to generate awareness among the people regarding intangible cultural heritage of the country. Annual grant-in-aid is provided by the Government of India to these ZCCs for this purpose.
