- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the States wherein more than 50 per cent of people are literate;
- (d) whether the Government has taken any step to improve the level of literacy in the remaining States;
- (e) if so, the details thereof;
- (f) whether the Government has started any awareness campaign to make each village and Dhani of Rajasthan literate; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

- (a) & (b) Yes Sir. A statement indicating details of State/UT-wise list of Performance Grading Index for the year 2017-18 in different domains is at **Annexure I.**
- (c) A statement indicating details of State/UT-wise literacy rate in the country in the age group of 7 and above, where more than 50 per cent of people are literate, as per census 2011 is at **Annexure II**.

- (d) & (e) In order to improve the level of literacy, the scheme of Saakshar Bharat was implemented in phased manner since October 2009 in the rural areas of 410 districts in 26 states and one UT that had adult female literacy rate of 50 percent and below as per Census 2001, and including left wing extremism affected districts, irrespective of their literacy rate. The scheme was extended upto 31.03.2018
- (f) & (g) Yes Sir. Awareness programmes were carried out in the rural areas of 32 districts except Kota in the state of Rajasthan under the scheme of Saakshar Bharat.
