2378. SHRIMATI SAJDA AHMED:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to open new Kendriya Vidayalayas across the country including West Bengal;
- (b) if so, the number of New KVs opened during the last three years across the country, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to open new KV in a joint venture with the Ministry of Railways on railway land and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government has received any proposal to set up new KV on railway land in Uluberia in West Bengal; and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

- (a) 50 new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) were sanctioned in the country in March, 2019 including 2 KVs in the State of West Bengal as mentioned below:-
 - (i) NFR Katihar, New Jalpaiguri.
 - (ii) CRPF Group Centre, Siliguri
- (b) During the last three years i.e. 2016-17 to 2018-19, 73 KVs have been opened in the country. The State / UT-wise details are annexed.
- (c) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has informed that there is no proposal received from Ministry of Railways to open KVs in a joint venture on railway land.
- (d) No proposal has been received in the prescribed proformae from the Ministry of Railways for opening of a new KV on railway land in Uluberia in West Bengal.
