- (a) the State-wise details of total number of Universities and Educational Institutions in the country which are not receiving grant from the Union/State Governments;
- (b) whether the Government has any scheme to encourage/upgrade such Universities and Educational Institutions;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(b) to (d):The Universities which are included under Section 12(B) of UGC Act-1956 are eligible to receive central assistance for the students and teacher centric schemes. As informed by UGC, as on 31.03.2019, 39 Deemed to be Universities and 7 Private Universities included under Section 12(B) of UGC Act, 1956 are receiving financial assistance.
