'Collateral Free Loan to MSMEs'

2386: DR. SUJAY RADHAKRISHNA VIKHE PATIL:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to introduce collateral-free loans upto Rs.50 lakhs for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government provides subsidy on interest on the loan to MSMEs for modernisation of their machines;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether the said subsidy is being provided to enterprises/establishments in all areas of the country or limited to the units related to area and products only and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) to (b): As per the extant guidelines of Reserve Bank of India (RBI), Scheduled Commercial Banks (SCBs) have been mandated to extend collateral-free loans up to Rs.10 lakh to units in the Micro and Small Enterprise (MSE) sector.
- In addition, Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) can avail guarantee under Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprise (CGTMSE) scheme for loans up to Rs.200 lakh extended to them without furnishing any collateral security.
- (c) to (e): Government operates schemes like Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (CLCSS), Amended Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (ATUFS), etc. across the country. These provide capital subsidy on institutional finance availed for upgradation/modernisation of machinery by MSMEs for products/ sectors/segments as specified under the schemes.

On all working capital or term loan (fresh and incremental) to MSME borrowers for loans up to Rs.1 crore, Government has also implemented the 'Interest Subvention Scheme for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), 2018' which provides interest subvention calculated at 2% per annum. This includes loans taken for technology upgradation.
