- (a) South Zone Cultural Centre (SZCC), Thanjavur, an autonomous organization under Ministry of Culture, invites artistes who are experts in various art forms including Bonalu art form from Telangana State for participation in various cultural activities organized by them in its member States. SZCC has conducted various cultural programmes in Telangana State viz. Telangana State Formation Day, Aadhi Mahotsav Tribal Festival, Navarathiri Festival, All India Craft Mela, Sankaranthi Festival, 250th Birth Anniversary Celebrations of Saint Thyagaraja, Dasara Festival, Rashtriya Ekta Diwas on the occasion of Birth Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, National Craft Mela and Ugadi Festival.
- (b) During 2018-19, financial assistance of Rs. 2.00 lakh was released to Shri Mokshagundam Vishweshwaraiah Cultural Society, Telangana, a Non Government Organization (NGO) for this festival under Cultural Function Production Grant Scheme (CFPGS) operating by this Ministry.
