#### HOUSES FOR CYCLONE AFFECTED PERSONS

#### 2603. SHRI MAHESH SAHOO:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether five lakh houses are likely to be sanctioned under PMAY-G by the Government specially for those persons whose houses got completely/substantially damaged by the severe cyclone Fani; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

# ANSWER MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

(a) & (b): Under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G), five percent of annual central allocation is retained at the Central Government level as a reserve fund. This fund is used for financing the proposals under Special Projects received from the States/UTs inter-alia for rehabilitation / relocation of families whose houses have been completely / substantially damaged on account of various factors including natural hazard viz., cyclone.

All the eligible rural households, who are included in the Permanent Wait List of PMAY-G and whose houses have been completely / substantially damaged on account of cyclone Fani, are eligible for sanctioning of houses under Special Projects of PMAY-G.
