(a) whether it is a fact that during the Eleventh Five Year Plan, there had been 3.3 per cent annual increase in the availability of foodgrains, if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether benefits of this increased availability of foodgrains have reached the common consumer; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor and the Government's reaction thereto?

(a): Stock position of foodgrains and the percentage increase in availability of foodgrains (taking 1st April of each year as base date) during 2007-2012 is as under:

It can be seen in the above table that there has been an annual increase of more than 3.3 percent in availability of foodgrains (taking 1st April of each year as base date) except for the year 2011, when the stock was increased by 3.14 percent against the preceding year.
