KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA IN GUJARAT

277. SHRI MOHANBHAI KALYANJI KUNDARIYA:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Government had taken a decision to set up a Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV) in each Constituency/ district across the country;
- (b) the number of districts in Gujarat where any KV has not been set up so far along with the total number of KVs functioning in Gujarat, District-wise;
- (c) whether the Government is considering to open more KVs in densely populated districts of Gujarat;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')**

(a) There is no decision to set up Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in each constituency / districts of the country.

(b) KVs have not been set up in 7 districts of Gujarat. The districts-wise information about KVs functioning in Gujarat is as under:-

Jamnagar – 7, Ahmedabad -6, Kutch -5, Gandhinagar – 5, Vadodara – 5, Surat– 3, Rajkot – 2 and 1 each in Bhavnagar, Banaskantha, Sabarjabtga, Junagarh, Porbander, Panchmahal, Dahod, Surendranagar, Anand, Bharuch, Mehsana and Patan districts.

(c) to (e) No such proposal is under consideration at present.
