(a) to (c) Yes, Sir.

In the overall interest of the nation and to ensure that project are planned and completed in time without cost overrun, lot of monitoring is done in Railways at various levels (field level, divisional level, zonal level and Board level) and regular meetings are held with the officials of State Government and concerned authorities to resolve the pending issues that are obstructing the progress of projects and such meetings is a regular process.

Based on above, 17 new line projects covering a length of 2027 km at a cost of ₹25599 cr in the State of Andhra Pradesh are in different stages of planning/approval/execution and 186 km length has been commissioned with expenditure of Rs.2834 crore upto March 2019.
