Scheme for Pension and Medical Aid to Artistes

281. SHRI ANNASAHEB SHANKAR JOLLE:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government bring in few changes in the Scheme for Pension and Medical Aid to Artists from the Ministry.
- (b) Whether it is a fact that the deserving artists are left out without pension and the rural folk arts need to be considered with priority and clear cut definitions.
- (c) Whether the Government had ever come across the matter regarding certification of the artists at the district level for proper identification of the artist during the past.
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not the steps taken/proposed to be taken in this regard to rectifying the loopholes in the scheme?

ANSWER
