- (a) whether adequate drinking water is not being supplied to the people particularly in district Dahod of Gujarat;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the funds allocated under Water and Sanitation Management Organisation (WASMO) scheme during the last three years to enable the supply of drinking water in adequate quantity to the people of Dahod district in Gujarat; and
- (d) the details of the schemes being run to make drinking water available in the said district?

- (a) to (c) Water is a State subject. As reported by State Government of Gujarat, all villages of Dahod district are covered with service level of 40 litre per capita per day (lpcd) as per norms. The funds allocated under Water and Sanitation Management Organisation (WASMO) scheme during the last three years are as under:-
