**TOLL RATES ON NHs**

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the criteria fixed by the Government for charging toll rates for all kinds of vehicles on National Highways (NHs) across the country;
- (b) whether the Government is considering to introduce a national policy for revising the existing toll rates for NHs and reclassifying the vehicle types and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has hired a consultancy firm to prepare a draft policy to revamp the toll system and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether there is a proposal to increase the toll rates for private cars and if so, the details and the objectives thereof; and
- (e) whether this is likely to upset car users and invite resentment from various quarters and if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?
