(a) whether there is any proposal toconvert sea water into potable water bysetting up of plants in Rameswaram tosolve water crisis in Tamil Nadu; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI RATTAN LAL KATARIA)

(a)& (b)Drinking water supply is a State subject. For improving the coverage of safe drinkingwater to rural population, this Ministry supplements the efforts of the States byproviding them with technical and financial assistance through the centrally sponsoredscheme National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP). It is the StateGovernments who plan, design, approve, execute, operate & maintain the schemes forproviding safe drinking water to rural population. States can utilize NRDWP coverage funds for providing safe drinking water to needy rural habitations.

The Ministry is not in receipt of any proposal for converting sea water into potable water by establishing desalination plant in Rameswaram from the Government of Tamil Nadu.
